The 'Lorna Doone' Challenge is a superb walk through the stunning scenery of Exmoor; England's only National Park with a coastline. The route starts on the breathtaking cliffs of the rugged North Devon coast before moving inland, through 'Doone Country', out onto high open moorland and finishes in spectacular style through the stunning East Lyn River valley. Along its way, the route passes the *Foreland point lighthouse*, the ancient spring at *Sisters Fountain*, the spectacular waterfalls at *Watersmeet* and many of the sites made famous by R.D. Blackmoor's classic novel *Lorna Doone*
